## Summary Report

### **Crowder State Park**

**Participants: 25 - All new**  
**Amount Spent: \$315.89**

Description: Participants met at Camp Grand River Dining Hall for a program about Notable Missourians. Following the powerpoint program participants ate lunch and then boarded the bus for a tour of Crowder State Park, the Thompson Cemetery and the Thompson House.

### **First Missouri State Capitol State Historic Site**

**Participants: 55 - 50 new**  
**Amount Spent: \$2,575.76**

Description: Our Seniors to Parks event is organized like a day camp for seniors. Participants choose activities each hour throughout the day including; lectures, historic crafts & skills and hands-on demonstrations. Lunch is included as well as historic period music.



### **St. Louis Area Office**

**Participants: 40 - 30 new**  
**Amount Spent: \$2,963.92**

Description: Grandparents Day was held in the yard space outside of the Scott Joplin House State Historic Site. Participants could come and garden with Northside Workshop, practice archery and atlatl, take a tour of Scott Joplin house and learn about the upcoming solar eclipses.

### **Weston Bend State Park**

**Participants: 70 (4 sessions) - All new**  
**Amount Spent: \$5,075.19**

Description: Participants from the Kansas City area were bussed to Weston Bend State Park to enjoy pastries and hot drinks prior to the tram tour. After the morning tour participants had lunch and enjoyed a presentation about the Iron Riders before the afternoon tram tour with a local group.

*Participants: 461 total, 356 of which were new*

*Expenses: \$11,373.79*



### **Katy Trail State Park**

**Participants: 271 (10 Sessions in the fall) - 181 new**  
**Amount Spent: \$443.03**

Description: Tuesdays on the Trail tram tours are round trips and last approximately 2 hours. A variety of routes offer visitors a chance to see stretches of the trail they may not be able to experience otherwise.
